



Covid-19 : Monthly Situation Bulletin

May 02, 2022

After a strong rebound in epidemic pressure in March/April linked to the Omicron variant, all of the countries where the group operates have seen a clear improvement in the health situation since mid-April. To date, more than 98% of infections remain linked to the different strains of the Omicron variant (BA.1 and BA.2 strains).

The health situation in our network has followed the same favourable trend with a general decrease in the number of positive persons: 1.3% of employees compared to 2.48% at the peak and 1.45% of residents compared to 3.8% and almost 100% of forms that remained non-symptomatic or only slightly symptomatic.

As a reminder, the vaccination coverage rate in our network is very high, with nearly 95% of residents and employees up to date with their booster. It should be noted that the 2nd booster campaign (4th dose) is currently underway in France and has been extended to people over 60.
