



Covid-19 : Weekly Situation Bulletin

April 04, 2022

On a national scale, the contamination curve continues to increase in France and Germany, while the other countries show signs of decrease or stabilisation. Nearly 100% of the contaminations are linked to the Omicron variant, of which 1/3 of the BA.1 strain and 2/3 of the BA.2 strain. It should be noted that 0.1% of contaminations in Spain are of the Delta variant.

In spite of this, the general health situation remains stable with a very large majority of non-symptomatic or slightly symptomatic forms. However, a resumption of hospitalizations in England has been noted for a few days.

In our network, we note a slight increase in the number of positive employees (2.48% compared to 2.25% last week), half of which (48%) are in Germany. The number of positive residents remains stable with 3.7% of people positive against 3.8% last week and nearly 99% of forms are not or only slightly symptomatic.

As a reminder, the vaccination coverage rate in our network is very high with nearly 95% of residents and employees up to date with their booster. Note that the 2nd booster campaign (4th dose) is underway in France and the Netherlands for people aged 80 and over.
