Acceleration of the vaccination of Korian employees

Our vaccination rates are excellent, with 99% of residents and 91% of staff fully protected.

In France, the last few weeks have been marked by the implementation of the health pass and the obligation for nursing staff to be vaccinated before 15 September. These decisions have helped us to increase the level of vaccination, which was already very high at the end of July. The mark of 20,000 employees fully vaccinated with the two doses was exceeded. As a result, 97% of residents and 86% of employees have been vaccinated with both doses.

This figure is expected to rise further in the coming days as employees return from their holidays and submit their vaccination certificates from August.

Epidemic situation in the Korian network

The health situation in our network remains stable in line with the high vaccination rates. To date, only 10 institutions (5 in France, 3 in Germany, 1 in Belgium and 1 in the Netherlands) have had 4 or more cases, with 154 Covid-19 positive residents in the entire European network, and 0.2% of the staff (health and medico-social sector).

The vast majority of positive patients are asymptomatic or minimally symptomatic.

3rd injection campaign

All countries are preparing to provide the 3rd dose during September. In France, the first orders were placed last week for all establishments with a launch of the campaign probably around 10 September. It should last 4 weeks.

The campaign is aimed at the elderly and not at staff.

Each institution can order 10 vials (i.e. 70 doses) per week, for 4 weeks.

Any remaining doses will be offered in priority to residents of day care centres, residents of service residences and family members aged over 80.

Hygiene standard and preventive measures

The situation has improved considerably thanks to vaccination, but the new mutations still call for vigilance and compliance with barrier measures.

Maintaining social life in facilities

In the Korian network, outings and visits are the rule. The Group has always been very careful to maintain the various social activities and visits in all its establishments, for the quality of life and comfort of residents and patients.
