



Covid-19 : Weekly Situation Bulletin

March 21th, 2022

On a national scale, the rebound in infections is confirmed in all the countries where the group is present, with the exception of Spain. A reduction in the number of new daily cases in the Netherlands should also be noted after a strong increase in recent days. Almost 100% of the infections are related to the Omicron variant and this rebound is possibly due to the emergence of the Omicron BA.2 sub-variant.

In spite of this, the sanitary situation continues to improve with a large majority of non-symptomatic or slightly symptomatic forms.

This trend is reflected in our network with a rebound in the number of positive collaborators (2.29% compared to 1.9% last week), more than half of which (56%) are in Germany. The number of positive residents remains stable with 3.41% positive and more than 98% of non-symptomatic or slightly symptomatic forms.

As a reminder, the vaccination coverage rate in our network is very high, with nearly 95% of residents and employees up to date with their booster. Note that the 2nd booster campaign (4th dose) has just been launched in France and the Netherlands for people aged 80 and over.
