



## **Covid-19 : Weekly Situation Bulletin**

### **Epidemic situation in the Korian network**

The sanitary situation in our network remains totally under control in connection with the high vaccination rates. To date, only 8 institutions (3 in France, 4 in Germany and 1 in Belgium) have 4 or more cases, i.e. 95 Covid-19 positive residents in the entire European network (health and medico-social sector).

The vast majority of positive patients are asymptomatic or only mildly symptomatic.

### **Acceleration of the vaccination of Korian employees**

Our vaccination rates are excellent, with over 99% of residents vaccinated.

The vaccination rates of our employees are also very high. In France in particular, where vaccination of nursing staff has been mandatory since 15 September, the rate of fully vaccinated employees has now reached 97%.

### **A campaign for 3rd injection spreading in Europe**

In France, Germany and Spain, the third dose vaccination campaign has already been launched and is being rapidly rolled out. 76% of residents have received the third dose in Spain, 31% in France and 14% in Germany.

This campaign is aimed at the elderly and not at staff.

Each institution can order 10 vials (i.e. 70 doses) per week for 4 weeks.

All remaining doses will be offered as a priority to day care residents, residents of assisted living facilities and family members over the age of 80.

### **Hygiene standard and preventive measures**

The situation has improved considerably thanks to vaccination, but the new mutations still call for vigilance and compliance with barrier measures.

### **Maintaining social life in facilities**

In the Korian network, outings and visits are the rule. The Group has always been very careful to maintain the various social activities and visits in all its establishments, for the quality of life and comfort of residents and patients.
