Covid-19 : Weekly Situation Bulletin

March 28th, 2022

On a national scale, the pattern of infections continues to increase in France, England, Italy and Belgium, while a sharp decrease has been observed in Germany and the Netherlands for several days. Almost 100% of the infections are linked to the Omicron variant.

In spite of this, the general sanitary situation remains stable with a very large majority of non-symptomatic or only slightly symptomatic forms.

In our network, the number of positive collaborators remains stable (2.25% against 2.29% last week), of which more than half (58%) are in Germany. The number of positive residents has increased slightly with 3.8% of positive persons (against 3.41% last week) and almost 99% of non-symptomatic or slightly symptomatic forms.

As a reminder, the vaccination coverage rate in our network is very high with nearly 95% of residents and employees up to date with their booster. Note that the 2nd booster campaign (4th dose) has been launched in France and the Netherlands for people aged 80 and over.
