Epidemic situation in Europe

The health situation in the countries where the group operates continues to improve, with the incidence falling below the "epidemic" threshold of 50/100,000 in Germany, Italy, France and Belgium.

In addition, national vaccination rates continue to improve with an average rate of 58% for the 1st dose and over 31% for the 2nd dose. It should be noted that the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine, widely used in our network, is 90% effective against the "Indian" or Delta variant.

Epidemic situation in the Korian network

The health situation in our network is very positive in relation to the high vaccination rates.

Thus, to date, we no longer have any facility in 4S (4 or more cases). In total, only 13 Covid+ residents (and 6 patients) are positive for Covid-19 in the entire European network, and 0.16% of employees (health and medico-social sector).

Vaccination campaign in the Korian network

Our vaccination rates are excellent, with 99% of residents and 79% of staff having received at least one dose of vaccine, and 96% of residents and 76% of staff fully protected. The team vaccination campaign in France is being actively pursued to reach 80%.

Testing policy

There are still around 80,000 tests carried out weekly on residents/patients or employees. In Germany, the frequency of testing for staff is one test per week for In Germany, the frequency of testing for employees is one test per week for facilities located in an area with an incidence of 50/100,000 or less and with an employee vaccination rate of over 70%.

Hygiene standard and preventive measures

Despite the considerable improvement in the situation, the new changes call for continued vigilance in respecting barrier measures.

Access to facilities, activities and visits

In view of the confirmation of the effectiveness of the vaccine protection, outings and free visits are the rule. Except for a particular and temporary local situation, visits are now made without making an appointment for vaccinated persons.

Even if vigilance remains necessary with the threat of new variants, the Korian network has always been very careful to maintain the various social activities and visits in all its establishments, for the quality of life and comfort of residents and patients.
